On the tour we will visit the historic **Grauman's Egyptian Theatre** built in 1922 as the first "palace theatre" built by theatrical impresario Sid Grauman five years before he built his world famous Chinese Theatre. We will also visit the historic **Hollywood Roosevelt Hotel**, site of the very first Academy Awards ceremony and financed in part by famed silent film actress Mary Pickford who wanted the landmark to reflect the architecture of a Spanish palace. We will visit the historic **El Capitan Theatre** built in 1926 as a legit theatre and where stars such as Clark Gable and Fred Astaire were "discovered" and landed careers in film. We will also see the world famous **Grauman's Chinese Theatre** and learn why the theatre was constructed on such a scale and we will also learn the story behind its famous foot prints of the star. Finally we will see and hear the story of the **Walk of Fame, Hollywood Sign**, and the **Kodak Theatre** (new home of the Academy Awards). As a grand finale we visit a real Speakeasy from Prohibition-era Hollywood.
