	Treasurer/Deputy Treasurer	Jeremy Wescoat/ Susan Johnson	<p>\$87,000 gross profit \$9000 net income \$25,000 bank account \$11,000 estimated balance Fiscal year ends May 31st</p> <p>Marching band fees are currently \$250 and could go to \$275 for fair share. Full share could go from \$400 to \$425. Proposed a fee range which depends on participation.</p> <p>Pat would like to show change that has occurred from last year to this year as everything has gone up substantially. Susan will work with Pat to do a budget spreadsheet.</p> <p>Pat said we should get Ginger to help collect fees. Susan said she sent out e-mail statements on May 1st to everyone who still owes money. Jeremy said he sent letters letting people know the fee collection will be turned over to the school. Pat mentioned scholarships have been offered. Pat mentioned we shouldn't spend a lot of time on last year's receivables. Jeremy said he wrote off last year's marching band. Pat offered to make some phone calls to help collect fees.</p>

Next one is Wednesday, May 24th 4-8 pm with new incoming Freshmen. Will have 1 rehearsal every two weeks throughout summer. 8 hour rehearsals instead of 4.</p>

Broomfield Days and Englewood Friendship cup will be on the same day again.
 Will have them put us last so we're not rushed.
 Will do Monarch Marching Festival.
 Friendship Cup at Prairie View.
 Pomona is prelims/finals show. If we make finals kids can leave right after to go to homecoming.
 Would like to stay in Colorado Springs (get hotel rooms) if have a good chance to make it to semi-finals.
 Compromised with rehearsal times – 4-8 pm instead of 3:30-7:30.

If football team is good this year we will be playing at playoffs.
 Want football team to come to regionals in uniform to watch band perform.

Need checks to pay for competitions.
 Monarch will be having a staff clinic with judges on Sunday following festival for \$75 and would like to attend.

Pat mentioned having the drum major attend camp at UNC.
 Ruben said there may be 2 drum majors this year.
 Pat asked how many Freshman are anticipated.
 Not sure yet as they are talking to Mr. Boccard to help fit marching band into their schedule.
 Band may stay the same size as last year.
 Susan asked how many seniors are leaving.
 There are around 11
 Corey said there are 41 returning members.
 Pat said that Ryan has a concert next week at Aspen Creek and would like to go talk to the parents.
 Ruben said he would also like to talk to parents after next week's meeting.
 We will have a good low brass section.
 Will get some kids from other districts.

Would like to budget in a couple of music education students at \$50-\$75 a rehearsal.
 Woodwind and mellophone specialist.
 Would like to pay Ryan something.
 Other schools have CU college students that work with kids for a few hours.
 Susan asked about the budget for clinicians. How often would you do it and what would we pay?
 Prop budget – would like thing that goes across front of field with the show theme printed on it.
 Susan asked for an estimate of what that would cost.

Would like to do a marching band trip.
 Advantage tours has a lot of experience in band trips.
 Do we want a competitive trip or marching in Disneyland?
 There was discussion on whether it should happen in fall of 2017 or fall of 2018.
 Dawn said to take a vote at parent meeting about what trip to take or no trip at all.

Met with Corey and Danny last week about silent auction for August 3rd at a brewery.
 This would be for parents to meet each other and ask questions.
 There is plenty of time to get things donated from businesses.
 Dawn said kids could bring something to be auctioned.
 Viola said each section can do a basket.

Show shirts cost \$300.
 If businesses donate \$300-\$500 dollars than company name can be on shirt.
 Susan asked each board member to come up with a sponsor to put on back of shirts.
