	Approval of minutes	Pat Quinn	Minutes approved
	Band Director Report	Ruben Romero	<p>Thank you to Viola and parents that helped on Saturday with tag day. A parent sent a nice letter to me and Ginger thanking the band.</p> <p>Viola mentioned it will be a good idea to do a yearly tracking of tag day. The GoFundMe account now has a little extra money. Put older kids in groups with younger ones so they can teach them.</p> <p>Pat mentioned that kids know what it means to fundraise after tag day.</p> <p>Schedule for Friday's Hospital performance – leave at 8:00 and be back by 10:00. Need truck for drums.</p> <p>Guard uniforms look amazing – mom made them. \$599 for uniforms. Got \$650 in donations for uniforms. Have receipts for some fabric. Mom came to watch kids on Friday at game.</p> <p>Would like to get lights for plumes - \$3.98.</p> <p>Cords for pit have come in today. Projected \$360, but lower than expected. Cords were old and damaged and were cutting out at games.</p> <p>28 bands on Saturday. Competition will be tough to make it to finals. We're up against really big, good bands. Top 13 go to finals: Top 2 1A bands, top 2 2A bands, top 2 3A bands, top 7 out of 4A & 5A</p>

			<p>Kids will get to see all the bands. Will head back after prelims if we don't make finals. Goal is to have a long day and be back at 11:00 pm.</p> <p>Located in Echo Park (not Sports Authority Stadium) in Parker.</p> <p>Will have a 15-minute clinic right after performance. More feedback for the kids with one of the judges.</p>
	President	Pat Quinn	<p>Analysis with Broomfield Cultural Council on October 6th.. Foundations don't usually fund operating budget. Can present to City of Broomfield with more specific items. May get \$500 this way.</p>
	1 st VP Marketing	Scott Cannon	<p>Check has been cashed for raffle license.</p> <p>Buffalo Wild Wings can do a Tuesday in December for restaurant fundraiser.</p> <p>Dawn Howe has made changes on the website. Need to go into publishing page to update website.</p>
	2 nd VP Human Resources	Viola De La O	<p>Each kid will get 10 raffle tickets to sell. Will try to sell them at the next two football games and the first half of the last game. Possibility of going door to door after practice to sell tickets.</p> <p>Need 1000, but can sell up to 1500. Can net \$10,000 if sell them all. 25% goes toward first prize (\$3750).</p> <p>Vouchers have been picked up for The Fray.</p> <p>Susan mentioned we should still try to get store front sales to help sell tickets. Viola said a Sunday or 4:30-6:30 in the evening might work.</p> <p>8th graders and families are coming to the next game.</p> <p>Thank you to everyone for help on tag day. Kids were excited. Have never seen that many people helping.</p> <p>Will be barbecuing hotdogs and hamburgers on Saturday at Legend.</p>
	Treasurer/Deputy Treasurer	Jeremy Westcoat/ Susan Johnson	<p>The bank balance is \$18,500. \$2,900 net concessions \$2,500 at Legacy game and \$1,400 at Greeley Central game.</p> <p>Chick-fil-A sandwiches don't make a lot, but get people to our concession stand.</p> <p>\$11,000 fundraising right now. Goal for marching band is \$15,000. \$25,000 for year, which includes winter guard and percussion without Dayton trip.</p> <p>Pat mentioned Ginger wants to help collect from kids who haven't paid fees yet.</p> <p>Pat would like to figure out how to give out \$1500 in scholarships.</p>

			<p>Staci said kids had to write an essay to get scholarship for orchestra.</p>
	<p>Percussion Instructor</p>	<p>Corey Anderson</p>	<p>Went over budget for Dayton trip. May be able to rent instruments as need more for 25 students to play. Danny writes show – need to pay for music writer. Uniforms - \$75 per student.</p> <p>Bold items lines on budget sheet are a set cost. First half of budget sheet is for local stuff for winter percussion and second half is for Dayton trip.</p> <p>Fly to Indy, stay one night, then drive to Dayton.</p> <p>Trip is April 20-22 World Championships on Saturday after competition. Tickets for this are \$72 per person. Total cost is \$46,818. Cost per student is \$1872.72. Deposit is 10% and is refundable.</p> <p>Susan asked about driving and Corey said that we will get a great deal on flights when book with Highlands Ranch for group discount.</p> <p>Fundraising ideas (set up in a google document): Bowl-a-thon Lollipops Candy bars Restaurant nights Donations Silent auction Letters to family/friends Golf tournament Dinner theater Yard sale Bake sale Poker tournament Fan cloth</p> <p>Hosting a show at BHS would be a great money making opportunity. Projected total fundraising - \$13,290 Total with fundraising - \$38,528 Cost per student - \$1541.12</p> <p>Viola – Last year winter percussion cost \$600. Staci – Band has bigger years when do a trip. Dawn – Spent \$1200 for trip to Disney years ago for oldest daughter. Staci – Important to have a competitive group. Don't want to lose Corey and Danny if we don't support them. Pay – May be better to plan for this trip for next year. Staci – Trip has been talked about for a couple of years. Show a video to show what it is all about. Ruben – Want to have a meeting in next couple of weeks. Lots of interest in newer students. Pat – Does color guard have potential to go to Dayton? Dawn – Would like to do it next year. Staci – Younger daughter wants to be involved.</p>

			<p>Jeremy – Need to gauge parent interest. Parents need to commit to fundraising/fees to gauge numbers and find out how much fundraising needs to be done.</p> <p>Pat – Fundraising can't fall on just a few parents. Find out how much people are willing to spend.</p> <p>Scott – Do a survey to find out interest.</p> <p>Pat – Do formal presentation. Have a meeting and find out interest and get commitment. Fundraising would need to be ramped up to pay bills in time for Dayton.</p> <p>Corey – Budget is on the high end. Driving may be cheaper, but a mental drain.</p> <p>Scott – Survey monkey is free and it is anonymous.</p> <p>Corey – Google survey is free and Corey will do this.</p> <p>Viola – Send Survey to everyone in school.</p> <p>Ruben – Kids will make it happen if really want to go.</p> <p>Corey – Most fundraising has to fall on the kids. What kids fundraise will go into their account.</p> <p>Ruben – Lollipops are a great fundraiser.</p> <p>Pat – Get survey out to parents. Community nights at First Bank Center. Need a signature event that people enjoy.</p>
